
PROCEDURE FOR ASSESSING ACCESS REQUESTS

PHASE ONE: ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ACCESS REQUEST



ENTRY INTO ACCESS AGREEMENT

One an Access Seeker has notified the Operator that it is satisfied with the terms and conditions set out in the Standard Customer Agreement (or any negotiated access agreement):

- i) The Operator will, as soon as is reasonably practicable, provide a final form of the access agreement (or, if applicable, an amendment to an existing access agreement) to the Access Seeker for execution; and
- ii) Both parties will use reasonable endeavours to execute the access agreement as soon as reasonably practicable following such notice.
