

The location is minutes to Sydney's arterial road network via M5 and M7. The site has further benefit from its proximity to both Interstate and IMEX Intermodal terminals 1.



Moorebank Intermodal Precinct will connect via the Interstate Terminal to Inland Rail network, allowing a direct link to Melbourne, Adelaide, Perth and Parkes. This network will enhance our nations freight and supply chain capabilities, connecting existing freight routes through rail, road and ports.




